# **Queensland**

Women/girls members increased nationally by **3.2%** in 2023/24.

The resultant gender mix reported for 2023/24 sees women/girls share of membership remain at **18.1%** of total members.

### Member Age Profile | Queensland

The average reported age of club members across Australia is 54.9 years. Men/boys have an average age of 53.1 years (53.9 last year) with women/girls averaging 19.9% higher at 63.7 years (64.8 last year).



#### Women/Girls Members by Cohort

The overall national movement in 2023/24 for member clubs (the aggregate of metropolitan and regional clubs) was an increase of 4.2%. All states saw growth, with both

Queensland and Tasmania reporting increases over 6%.

#### **Social Clubs:**

Registered clubs without full affiliation, which typically play in allotted tee times at public courses but may also be 'virtual' in nature, that is, creating handicaps for their members to play in any event at any course.


#### **Member Clubs:**

#### **BDLGA Pennants Report - April 2025**

#### 2025 season

- Pennant competitions were scheduled to commence on Sunday, 9 March 2025 and Friday, 14 March 2025. Instead we experienced damaging winds and the wettest day in 50 years thanks to Cyclone Alfred. The weather impacts did not stop there with further prolonged rainfall and ex Cyclone Diane bringing more flooding.
- Thankfully the waters subsided, and with amazing efforts by maintenance teams and volunteers, some Pennant matches were able to proceed.
  - Friday Pennants out of the 14 scheduled matches, only five have been played with six rescheduled and three cancelled due to host club availability.
  - o **Sunday pennants** 12 matches were scheduled, but only four matches have been played, five rescheduled and three cancelled due to suitability of dates.
- Most of the matches have been rescheduled, however we did have to look at alternative
  options to ensure the matches could proceed and would be suitable for both the host clubs
  and players.
  - Three of our Sunday Pennant matches have been rescheduled to Sunday, 27 April 2025, which is within the mid-season break.
  - o Friday Emerald pennants will play their rescheduled match at Virginia Golf Club on Monday, 19 May 2025.
- We are currently in the mid-season break, to allow for school holidays, public holidays and Mother's Day. Pennant competitions will resume after the break on Friday, 2 May 2025 and Sunday, 18 May 2025 (following the three matches this weekend).
  - o Friday Pennants 20 Pennant matches remaining.
  - o Sunday Pennants 12 Pennant matches remaining.

#### **Pennant regulations**

- Pace of play to maintain pace of play, players should take their shot within 40 seconds of getting to the ball, take a maximum of three minutes to search for a lost ball, and players are encouraged to offer 'gimmie' putts to their opponent.
- **Use of carts** if weather does not permit carts on the course on the day of competition, the matches will proceed unless the course is closed.
- Roles of players the player is ultimately responsible for their actions and decisions during a round of golf, even if they are advised by their caddy.
- Roles of caddies a caddy can provide advice and help in various ways, but they cannot
  make decisions or rulings on behalf of the player, nor can they concede a stroke, hole or
  match for the player.
- Juniors the minimum age for the pennant competitions is 13 years on the first day of competition. The caddy for the junior player must hold a Blue Card, or if their parent is caddying, no Blue Card is required.
- Matchplay order of play if you play out of turn, your opponent may cancel that stroke and make you play again.

#### **BDLGA** website

- The pennant competition draws have had multiple updates throughout the season and the current draw for each division is available on the BDLGA website.
- The results for each division are also available on the Pennant's page of the BDLGA website. This will be updated directly from the result entered to the Team Match Portal in Golf Genius.

Our second event, the **District Championships**, will be held at **McLeod Golf Club** on **27 June 2025**. Entries will open for this event on 14 May 2025 so please ensure your members are aware of this competition. It is a single stroke event across 3 divisions and Senior and Senior Veterans categories with Gross and Net being contested. Our famous **Champion of Champions** held in conjunction with the District Championships sees the best of our current Club BDLGA champions dueling it out which makes for some fantastic golf. Winners of Gross and Net for all divisions qualify to represent our BDLGA team in the **State Interdistrict 3-day Championship** to be held at **Royal Pines** in **November 2025**.

On 6 August 2025 we are holding a Blitzer event at Toogoolawah Golf Club. This NEW event is based on the Blitz Golf format.
