President's Report July 2024

Welcome Delegates, Guests, Observers and Members to our BDLGA meeting. You will see some new faces here on the Committee and we have had some changes since our last meeting. Kirsty James has stepped down from the Committee and Gillian Di Corleto has taken on the role of Treasurer. Due to our reduced numbers on the Committee and after a plea from us at the Pennant Meeting we are excited that Lisa Laney from Virginia GC, Roslyn Pickels from Wynnum GC and Cathy Hindmarsh from Bulimba CG all nominated to become Committee members. A big thank you and welcome to our new District Committee members Lisa, Roslyn & Cathy. I would also like to thank our continuing members for their commitment and representation of our Association. There are many proposed changes afoot to golf as a whole in our state and we need diverse views and representation to assist our district moving forward.

Last month I attended the Golf Queensland meeting. The final format and conditions around the new Qld Inter-district Championships was presented. This event will be held over 3 days with a team of 6 players per gender per district; 2 players from each Division/Grade; 3 rounds of stableford golf would be played (converted to Gross and Nett) and points awarded to individual and team results presented on the last day. It will be held at Royal Pines Resort on November 10th - 12th 2024. The BDLGA has selected players for our team who support the BDLGA and are also very competitive in their golfing divisions.

Our 2024 team comprises players who won the Gross and Nett Winner across 3 divisions of our 2024 District Championships. The team is Kylie Jackson - Wynnum, Di Paez - McLeod, Donna Beacham - Redland Bay, Amy Kim - Windaroo, Judy Noble - Redland Bay, Nicole Stanfield - Boonah. Moving forward we will look at hosting our Championships each year with the same divisions so the winners of the Gross and Nett can be selected. if available.

Pennant's Report July 2024

Pennant results for the 2024 season were as follows:

Over all divisions, **21 Clubs** entered **53 teams** (58 if Weekend Bronze Zone 2 included). 33 Weekday and 25 Weekend Teams.

Over all divisions, **25 Clubs** entered a total of **44 teams**, 24 weekday teams and 18 Weekend teams. All teams were of seven players.

Off the Stick (OTS) Competition - as in 2023 year, clubs were again canvassed as to whether they could enter teams in a purely OTS competition. The proposal was for teams of three. Even with such a low number of players, there were not four teams (sic Clubs) who would field a team either on Friday or Sunday. It was decided therefore that a pennant would be awarded to the Club whose OTS players in Yellow Diamond won the most matches. This is seen as a way of recognising the 'elite' players while ensuring that there are sufficient numbers of Clubs to participate to provide a competition.

Pennant Organisers Meeting on 8 June - representatives of **17 Clubs** attended the Pennant Organisers Meeting we held on 8 June 2024. The meeting allowed discussion on various issues

and highlighted that many issues had different effects on varying Clubs. Issues that arose during the year were discussed including:-

- administration problems with Golf Genius and email communications;
- the handicap differences and cut offs;
- number of players in a team;
- provision of food for players and caddies;
- slow play;
- use of and charges for carts; and
- presentation of Pennants.

While the provision of lunches by some Clubs was greatly appreciated by the players and caddies it was recognised that not all Clubs were in a position to do so and this will be recognised in the Pennant Regulations for 2025.

Clubs will be asked to provide an estimate of costs of hiring carts for pennant players and caddies in 2025.

Guidelines for preventing slow play will be distributed to Clubs so team captains can educate their members.

Clubs will be asked if they can facilitate presentations on the final day of competition by allowing a two-tee start or a shotgun start.

Email communications will be sent to team captains and club representatives via Golf Genius.

Pennant Structure for 2025 - after considering the feedback on the 2024 structure of BDLGA Pennants it was decided:

the fundamental structure of Yellow Diamond and Sapphire will remain; however the
upper limit for Sapphire divisions will be a GA of 28, and a new division will be introduced Emerald with a minimum GA of 20 and a maximum GA of 36. Emerald teams will consist of
5 players.

Proposed Dates for Pennants in 2025 - due to the date of Easter, Anzac Day and Labour Day it will be necessary to split the 2025 season into two parts i.e. **Friday Pennants** - commencing Friday 14 March, 21 March, 28 March, 4 April, break, 2 May, 9 May, 16 May, 23 May, 30 May, 6 June; and **Sunday Pennants** - commencing Sunday 9 March, 16 March, 30 March, break, 18 May, 25 May, 1 June, 8 June, 15 June, 22 June.

These dates provide a window. The Committee is cognisant of the fact March can be very hot still and the length of time. We will try to condense the actual draws as much as possible.

Timing of Organisation of Pennants for 2025 - Intention to Compete Forms have already been distributed to Clubs and will be available on the BDLGA website. Intentions to Compete Forms are to be lodged by **2 September 2024** with the aim of dates for venues being confirmed by the end of September. There will be a meeting held around the beginning of March 2025 to ensure teams and players are inputted into Golf Genius and to teach any new pennant captains how to use Golf Genius.

I would like to thank the other members of the Pennant Sub-committee - Renai Ridley and Jacque Giles for their help again this year. Renai in particular had the task of looking after the competition this year while I was away. I would also like to thank our outgoing Secretary Donna Beecham who provided great assistance again this year.
